In order to become a National Senior Beta Club member through Lithonia High School, you must meet the following criteria:

- ❖ Have an overall GPA of 3.00
- ❖ Display good character, attitude, and leadership abilities
- ❖ Maintain a clear disciplinary record **(No referrals)***
- ❖ Participate in Beta-Club sponsored school and community-related activities
- ❖ Attend the **mandatory** formal induction ceremony

The process for applying is as follows:

- ❖ Complete this application in full by **Friday, September 14, 2018**. Two teacher recommendations are required. See form attached.
- ❖ **Membership fee of the following amounts are due once membership is granted.**
 - **\$43.00 cash - NEW Senior Members only**
 - **\$35.00 cash - New & Returning Sophomore, Junior, Senior Members**

❖ **Fee is non-refundable.**

❖ **If students receive discipline referrals during the school year, their membership can be terminated.**

- The sponsor will write a receipt for all monies received. Do not submit money without receiving a proper receipt from the sponsor, Ms. Fletcher
- **I am only available to take monies during the following times:**
 - 7:50am - 8:10am (before school)**
 - 12:00am-12:30pm (during B lunch)**
 - 3:15pm -3:45pm (after school)**

You will be informed in writing of your acceptance into the National Beta Club.

A formal Induction Ceremony will be held in December (tentative). You must attend the induction ceremony in order to become a member. Family and friends are invited.

Attire: Inductees are required to wear all black attire. Female students should wear black skirts and tops or a black dress. Male students will wear black suits, white dress shirts and tie.

Rehearsals are usually held after school on Monday and Tuesday of the induction week in the auditorium.

Communication this year will take place using Remind101. It is your responsibility to check your text messages daily.

Meetings: The Beta Club meets twice a month which will be held on the **2nd and 4th Thursday of each month**. Your schedule must allow you to be present and on time for each meeting to continue your membership.

Community Service: Must do 5 hours of community service during the fall semester and 5 hours of community service during the spring semester.
